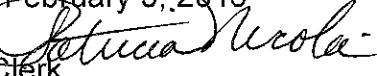
PER CURIAM

AND NOW, this 5th day of February, 2016, because Petitioner did not seek recusal at the earliest possible time, her objection is waived as a matter of law and cannot form the basis to invalidate a judicial determination. See Goodheart v. Casey, 565 A.2d 757, 763 (Pa. 1989). Petitioner's claims of bias are untimely and are not properly before this Court for consideration.
