ORDER

AND NOW, this 27th day of November, 2013, upon consideration of the Application, by C. Alan Walker, Secretary for the Department of Community and Economic Development, requesting extension of the Receivership for the City of Harrisburg, consideration of the City's joinder in the request for extension and in the absence of any opposition to the request, the Application is hereby GRANTED.

Further, in view of the fact that the City of Harrisburg remains in a state of fiscal emergency, implementation of the fiscal recovery plan ("Harrisburg Strong Plan") is necessary to alleviate the fiscal emergency and Plan implementation requires the continued service of the Receiver, the Receivership is extended for an additional two years to end on December 1, 2015, unless sooner terminated by operation of Act 47¹ or further Order.
