## Narrative:

On 10-13-2013 at about 1148 hrs. patrol officers were dispatched to the area of N 3<sup>rd</sup> and Hamilton Streets for a possible robbery that had just occurred, (2) males observed running with a pocket book in their hands. A description was put out for a white male suspect wearing a #7 Eagles jersey and another male with a black hoodie. Officers received a report from the victims who reported they were walking in the area when they were approached by the robbers. A white male displayed a handgun and demanded their purses. Another male behind them repeated the demand. They fled the area after taking the purses. The victims were not physically injured. Contact was made with **Jeffery Eutzy** after he was observed in the 300 block of Hamilton Street with another male, **Robert Williamson**, matching the description. Both entered a residence after seeing police officers. Upon speaking with Eutzy the victims positively identified him as the robber with the gun. One of the victim's purses was recovered

along with a BB gun and black hoodie in close proximity to the residence Eutzy and Williamson entered. Found in the rear yard of the residence Eutzy and Williamson entered was a #7 Eagles jersey. Eutzy was taken into custody. Williamson was also taken into custody after being found hiding inside of a closet inside of the residence. He fought with officers who attempted to detain him, and upon being placed into a police vehicle he broke free and fled from officers. He was tased and during the process managed to pulled the taser from a police officer. Police were able to regain possession of the taser. Williamson later confessed to detectives his involvement in the robbery. Both are awaiting arraignment .See attached photos.
